Hold Harmless Agreement

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. "Engages in an equine activity" means riding, training, assisting in Veterinary treatment of, driving, or being a passenger upon an equine, whether mounted or unmounted, visiting or touring or utilizing an equine facility as part of an organized event or activity, or any person assisting a participant or show management. The term "engages in an equine activity" does not include being a spectator at an equine activity, except in cases where a spectator places himself or herself in an unauthorized area.

In consideration of the acceptance of my participation and/or the participation of my child or ward, in the horseback riding activities, lessons and/or volunteer work days offered by Mad Hatter Farm and with the understanding that a horse may be startled by sudden movement, noise or other factors, and may shy suddenly, rear, stop short, bite, buck, kick or run with its rider, by my signature hereon, I hereby assume all risks associated with horseback riding and associated activities including, but not limited to, those risks set out above, and hereby waive any and all claims, actions and causes of action that may now or hereafter have against, and release and will indemnify and hold harmless from the same Mad Hatter Farms, and its officers, directors, stockholders, affiliates, employees and agents, for all injuries and damages that I or my minor child or ward may suffer or sustain in connection with or arising from my participation or my minor child's or ward's participation in the horseback riding and associated activities offered at Mad Hatter Farm, even if due to any negligence on the part of any of them.

This Participation and Waiver Agreement shall be binding upon me and my heirs, personal representatives and assigns, as well as those of my child or ward (if for a minor). I understand that this Participation and Waiver Agreement will be kept on file and shall apply to each time I use one or more horses and equipment to participate in horseback riding activities and/or volunteer workdays. If any information given below changes, I will give Mad Hatter Farm enough notice of such change. I agree that Mad Hatter Farm shall not be obligated to inquire if there have been changes each time I or my child, participates in horseback riding activities, volunteer workdays etc. I understand that by signing this form, I am bound by the liability laws of the state of Georgia, and any rules or policies held by Mad Hatter Farm in their entirety.

I HAVE READ, I UNDERSTAND, AND I WISH TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS PARTICIPATION AND WAIVER AGREEMENT.

_____ I understand that the behavior and actions of any equine or other animal on the farm can be unpredictable and that in working with animals, personal injury or property damage may occur. Being aware of the risks that may be involved, I indemnify and hold harmless Mad Hatter Farm and Rescue and/or their volunteers, employees, and family for any and all personal injury or property damage resulting from my participation.

_____ I agree to obey all posted signs and safety rules and to alert the staff to any rule violations or dangerous behavior of co-participants. I agree to stay in areas to which I am assigned and not enter any other areas without

permission. As an adult, if applicable, I will supervise my child(ren) at all times. Participation is solely at the discretion of the owners and staff members of the farm. I will follow their direction and keep the safety of others and the animals in mind when I take action.

_____ Interacting with farm animals is an important experience for children and adults. Being able to touch and watch the animals helps people to learn about agriculture and encourages the human-animal bond. Despite the many benefits of interacting with farm animals, people should be aware that farm animals can sometimes carry germs that make people sick. I will protect myself, my family, and the animals on the farm by remembering to wash my hands with soap and warm running water for at least 20 seconds after contact with farm animals. Mad Hatter Farm and Rescue is not responsible for any illness or injury resulting from any animal or activity on the property.

_____ I understand that photographs, pictures, slides, movies, or videos may be taken of me and my guests in connection with my participation in farm activities, and that these pictures may be used on the Mad Hatter Farm website, posted on Facebook, or other social media sites.
